At Bough Beech Sailing Club on Saturday 30^{th} April 2016

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The event will be hosted, organised and managed by Sevenoaks School and Tonbridge School Sailing Club

2. Rules

Races will be sailed under the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-16 including Appendix D. In the event of any conflict between these rules, those of the Sailing Instructions or Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

3. Eligibility

FIREFLY DIVISION

Teams may represent a single school, sailing club or association and shall consist of six persons, of which only three need helm. All competitors must be in full time attendance at secondary school and be under 19 years of age on the 1st September 2016. Each team must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

FEVA DIVISION

Teams may represent a single school, sailing club or association and shall consist of four persons, of which only two need helm. All competitors must be in full time attendance at secondary school and be under 17 years of age on the 1st September 2016. Each team must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

4. **R**EGISTRATION

Each team must register on arrival at Bough Beech. Registration will be from 09.00 AM in the Clubhouse. Briefing will commence at 09.30 AM with the first start planned for 10.00 AM.

5. ENTRIES

Entries are initially requested as expressions of interest to axc@sevenoaksschool.org. The Entry Fee will be £60 per firefly Team and £40 for fevas. The Entry Fee should ideally arrive before the event but will be accepted on the day. However teams will not be allowed to race without payment.

6. BOATS

The event will be sailed in Fireflies and Fevas; all boats will be provided by the organisers.

- 7. FORMAT OF RACING Will be announced at the briefing
- 8. COURSE TO BE SAILED

Subject to weather conditions, the course will likely be in the form of a Starboard hand "S" course for fireflies and port hand box for fevas. Any change to this instruction will be made clear at the briefing.

9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

a) The Hoad Shield – to the winning team whose members all attend the same school.

Other prizes may be awarded at the organisers' discretion.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

These will be available at registration and during the event.

11. SCORING SYSTEM

The event will be scored in accordance with Rule D4.

12. U m p i r i n g

The event will be umpired in accordance to Rule D2.3 (a).

13. CATERING

The Galley will be open serving both hot and cold food.

14. **D** A M A G E

A physical damage deposit will not be required – but the entry form will require the signing of a disclaimer accepting responsibility for any damage caused by the entering team, up to £200.

15. CANCELLATION

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event. Entry fees and deposits will be refunded.
